# Community Engagement and Collaboration: working together for families with young children

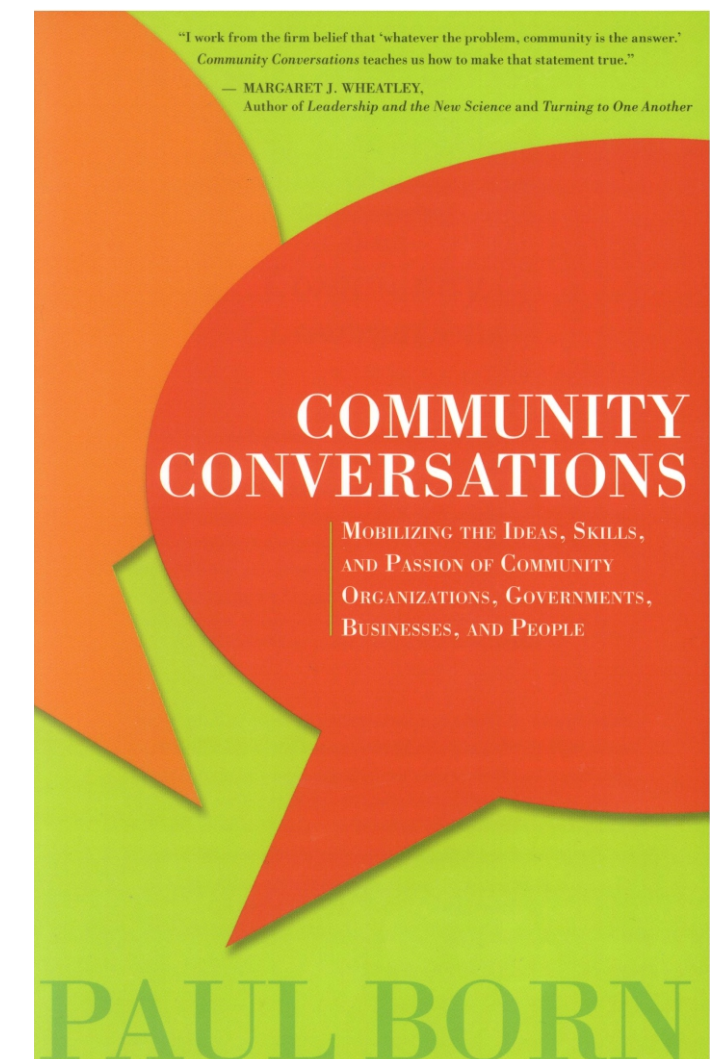
